NOTES ON 2020

POOL HIRE. 2020.

Pool hire for 2020 Jan to December was £11,355.9. This involved 7 months swimming. January, February, March, August, September, October and December were swum. This equates to £1,298.02 for pool hire per calendar month for January, February and March with an average of 28.75 hours swum per calendar month at a cost of £45.15 per hour pool hire

However for the month of December the pool hire cost was £1,865.46 per month, with an average of 19.63 hours swum per month (around 5 hours per week) with an average cost per hour of £95.06 for pool hire. This is a doubling of the most fundamental charge the club must bear.

Pool hire may be more expensive than £95.06 per hour this coming year given:

- The scarcity of pool time to hire and the number of clubs trying to book.
- The extra costs providers have to incur to start their pools up again and the reduced bather load possible per session given Covid restrictions are likely to be in place for some time.
- Many private hire pools require clubs to employ their own lifeguards and are specific about
 the qualifications the lifeguard must have. Lifeguarding costs for the 7 months of 2020
 swimming were £295.00 in addition to the pool hire costs, (the remainder of £120 from the
 £415.00 paid in 2020 for lifeguards being incurred in 2019.)

In February 2021 the Club paid the Swim England membership fees for its members totalling £735.20. The essential task for the non-swimming months ahead is to rebuild the club's operating reserve to a functional level and to raise £2,572.34 to enable the club to restart successfully.

REPLENISH OPERATING RESERVE TO ENSURE CLUB CAN RESTART.

The operating reserve is for emergency use. This is calculated as three months average pool hire cost (taken at 7 hours per week swim time with a £95.00 per hour pool hire) £2,549.16 x 3 = £7,647.50, 3 = £7,647.50, a months average dry hire at £300.00, a month's members' total subscription fee totalling £1,200, and £1,000 for miscellaneous costs and Club Hardship and Reduction of Fees due to Injury Policies. *This totals* £10,147.50 and is the sum needed to allow the Club to book venues and operate the club until members' subscriptions start to be banked.

In order to book pool time from August 2020 to December 2020 and to keep member's fees at an affordable level the club subsidised pool costs in the amount of £1,207.00 i.e. the members fees were £1,207.00 less than pool hire charges in this period. This was just to allow 19.63 hours swimming per calendar month (5 hours per week), compared to an expectation of 28.75 hours per calendar month (7.5 hours per week) which would be swum as a minimum in pre-Covid times.

Our operating reserve to enable the club to restart has now dropped to £8,494.56 which is £1,652.94 below the level needed to restart the club successfully. We are taking every measure we can to enable this reserve to be built up again to allow the successful reemergence of our club.
