Main Duties

- 1. Promote the vision of Oxford and Witney Artistic Swimming Club.
- 2. Follow and promote all Club Policies and Objectives.
- 3. Facilitate & promote the engagement of non-majority demographics of the Club (which may include culturally diverse members, members with disabilities, female identifying members, gender diverse members and LGBTQIA+ members and indigenous members).
- 4. To promote Inclusivity, equity, disability awareness training courses for club volunteers, teachers, and coaches. To identify any additional training needs within the Club in relation to Inclusivity.
- 5. Ensure that OWASC communications can be understood clearly by all members (e.g avoiding the use of slang and idioms); provide and monitor use of appropriate ways to communicate and behave inclusively.
- 6. Be an accessible contact for members, and coaches for matters regarding equitable events, activities, conduct and diversity within the Club. Keep apprised of any significant issues affecting members from non-majority demographics within the Club and report any relevant issues to the Club Committee.
- 7. Coordinate with OWASC Welfare Officer regarding Inclusivity of OWASC members & Volunteers.
- 8. To attend meetings as required.
- 9. Follow and promote the Swim England Child Protection policy.
- 10. Follow and promote the Swim England Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion Policy.
